
Monday January 10, 2022 Psalms 4 "Enlarged"

Vs.1 Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness! You have (enlarged) relieved me in my distress; Have mercy on me, and hear my prayer.

Vs. 3 But know that the Lord has set apart for Himself him who is godly; The Lord will hear when I call to Him.

Brian Reynolds contrasts the physics of materials where pressure makes things smaller with the spiritual being enlarged under pressure. Romans 5:1-5

My sense of this is the focus changes from one thing, which is out of proportion in distress to the correct larger view. Bifocal glasses, not in your tiny little world. Pejorative: "You live in a small world"



Tuesday January 11, 2022 2 Chronicles 21:4 Lessons on Jehoram

- Now when Jehoram was established over the kingdom of his father, he strengthened himself and killed all his brothers with the sword, and also others of the princes of Israel.
- Quoting Proverbs 3:5 "trust in the Lord... He will direct thy paths."
- Matthew 7:24 the wise man and the foolish man.

- "I would have despaired unless I had believed that I would see the goodness of the Lord In the land of the living." NASB




Wednesday January 12 Hebrews 4:16

Thursday January 13, 2022 1 Kings 8:30


- And may You hear the supplication of Your servant and of Your people Israel, when they pray toward this place. Hear in heaven Your dwelling place; and when You hear, forgive.

• Kintsugi (金継ぎ, "golden joinery"), also known as kintsukuroi (金繕い, "golden repair"), is the Japanese art of repairing broken pottery by mending the areas of breakage with lacquer dusted or mixed with powdered gold, silver, or platinum; the method is similar to the makietechnique
