## Preview

- We saw David defeat Goliath with a sling and a stone.
- We saw the in scripture the importance of putting on the whole armor of God – that we will be able to withstand the whiles of the devil.
- The hope of this lesson is to show a comparison of Goliath to Satan the Devil.

# Goliath – Satan the Devil

- 1 Samuel 17:4 (NKJV) (action and size)
   <sup>4</sup> And a champion went out from the camp of the Philistines, named Goliath, from Gath, whose height was six cubits and a span.
- Job 1:6-7 (NKJV) (going to and fro)
   <sup>6</sup> Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan also came among them.

<sup>7</sup> And the LORD said to Satan, "From where do you come?" So Satan answered the LORD and said, "From <u>going to and fro on the earth</u>, and from walking back and forth on it."

- 1 Chronicles 21:1, 7 (NKJV) (stood against)
  - <sup>1</sup> Now Satan <u>stood up against Israel</u>, and moved David to number Israel.
     <sup>7</sup> And God was displeased with this thing;
  - therefore He struck Israel.
- Zechariah 3:1 (NKJV) (opposing)
  - <sup>1</sup> Then he showed me Joshua the high priest standing before the Angel of the LORD, and <u>Satan standing at his right hand to oppose</u> <u>him</u>.
- Matthew 4:1-2 (NKJV) (tempting)

<sup>1</sup> Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be <u>tempted by the devil</u>.

<sup>2</sup> And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, afterward He was hungry.

• 1 Samuel 17:8-10 (NKJV) (defying cry that is both boastful and confident of victory)

<sup>8</sup> Then he stood and <u>cried out</u> to the armies of Israel, and said to them, "Why have you come out to line up for battle? Am I not a Philistine, and you the servants of Saul? Choose a man for yourselves, and let him come down to me.

<sup>9</sup> If he is able to fight with me and kill me, then we will be your servants. But if I prevail against him and kill him, then you shall be our servants and serve us."

<sup>10</sup> And the Philistine said, "<u>I defy the armies of</u> <u>Israel this day</u>; give me a man, that we may fight together."

• 1 Peter 5:8 (NKJV) (roaring)

<sup>8</sup> Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the <u>devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom</u> <u>he may devour</u>.

• Luke 4:5-7 (NKJV) (boastful of glory and authority)

<sup>5</sup> Then the devil, taking Him up on a high mountain, showed Him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time.

<sup>6</sup> And the devil said to Him, "<u>All this</u> <u>authority I will give You, and their glory</u>; for *this* has been delivered to me, and I give it to whomever I wish.

<sup>7</sup> Therefore, <u>if You will worship before me</u>, all will be Yours."

 Luke 22:31-32 (NKJV) (defying and drawing away)

<sup>31</sup> And the Lord said, "Simon, Simon! Indeed, <u>Satan has asked for you</u>, that he may sift you as wheat.

<sup>32</sup> But I have prayed for you, that your faith should not fail; and <u>when you have returned</u> <u>to *Me*</u>, strengthen your brethren."

### • Revelation 12:9-10 (NKJV) (accusing)

<sup>9</sup> So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; .... for the <u>accuser</u> <u>of our brethren, who accused them before our</u> <u>God day and night</u>, has been cast down.

- 1 Samuel 17:11 (NKJV) (causing fear and lack of trust)
  - <sup>11</sup> When Saul and all Israel heard these words of the Philistine, they were dismayed and greatly afraid.
- 2 Corinthians 12:7 (NKJV) (buffeting/troubling)
   <sup>7</sup> And lest I should be exalted above measure by the abundance of the revelations, <u>a thorn in the</u> <u>flesh was given to me</u>, <u>a messenger of Satan to</u> <u>buffet me</u>, lest I be exalted above measure.
- 2 Corinthians 11:13-14 (NKJV) (deceptive)

   <sup>13</sup> For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into apostles of Christ.
   <sup>14</sup> And no wonder! For Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light.

 2 Corinthians 4:3-4 (NKJV)(blinding of the truth)
 <sup>3</sup> But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing,

<sup>4</sup> whose minds the <u>god of this age has blinded</u>, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them. • 1 Samuel 17:43(NKJV) (Goliath's cursing)

<sup>43</sup> So the Philistine said to David, "*Am* I a dog, that you come to me with sticks?" And the <u>Philistine</u> <u>cursed David by his gods</u>.

1 Samuel 17:45-47 (NKJV) (David's confidence)
 <sup>45</sup> Then David said to the Philistine, "You come to
 me with a sword, with a spear, and with a javelin.
 But I come to you in the name of the LORD of hosts,
 the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have
 defied.

<sup>46</sup> This day the LORD will deliver you into my hand,... that all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel.

<sup>47</sup> Then all this assembly shall know that the LORD does not save with sword and spear; for the battle *is* the LORD'S, and He will give you into our hands."

 Jude 1:9 (NKJV) (Giving the outcome to the Lord)

<sup>9</sup> Yet Michael the archangel, in contending with the devil, when he disputed about the body of Moses, dared not bring against him a reviling accusation, but said, "<u>The Lord rebuke you</u>!"

• Luke 4:7-8 (NKJV) (It is written)

<sup>7</sup> Therefore, if You will worship before me, all will be Yours."

<sup>8</sup> And Jesus answered and said to him, "<u>Get</u> <u>behind Me, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall</u> <u>worship the LORD your God, and Him only you</u> <u>shall serve.'</u> " 1 Samuel 17:50 (NKJV) (victory)

<sup>50</sup> So <u>David prevailed</u> over the Philistine with a sling and a stone, and struck the Philistine and killed him. But there was no sword in the hand of David.

• Luke 10:17-18 (NKJV) (falling)

<sup>17</sup> Then the seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name."

<sup>18</sup> And He said to them, "I saw <u>Satan fall like</u> <u>lightning</u> from heaven.

#### • Revelation 20:10 (NKJV) (cast down)

<sup>10</sup> The devil, who deceived them, was <u>cast into the</u> <u>lake of fire</u> and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet *are*. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

- 1 Samuel 17:51 (NKJV) (Fleeing enemy) <u>When the Philistines saw that their champion</u> <u>was dead, they fled.</u>
- James 4:7 (NKJV) (he will flee)
   <sup>7</sup> Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and <u>he will flee</u> from you.
- Ephesians 6:10-11 (NKJV) (his attacks overcome with God's armor)

<sup>10</sup> Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might.

<sup>11</sup> Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

- Isaiah 14:12-15 (NKJV) (Satan's rebellion) <sup>12</sup> "How you are fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! *How* you are cut down to the ground, You who weakened the nations! <sup>13</sup> For you have said in your heart: 'I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation On the farthest sides of the north;
  - <sup>14</sup> I will ascend above the heights of the clouds,
     I will be like the Most High.'
  - <sup>15</sup> Yet you shall be brought down to Sheol, To the lowest depths of the Pit.

#### • Ezekiel 28:12-17 (NKJV) (Satan's fall)

<sup>12</sup> "....Thus says the Lord GOD: "You *were* the seal of perfection, Full of wisdom and perfect in beauty.

<sup>13</sup> You were in Eden, the garden of God; Every precious stone *was* your covering: ....<sup>14</sup> "You *were* the anointed cherub who covers; I established you; You were on the holy mountain of God; You walked back and forth in the midst of fiery stones.

<sup>15</sup> You *were* perfect in your ways from the day you were created, Till iniquity was found in you. .....<sup>17</sup> "Your heart was lifted up because of your beauty; You corrupted your wisdom for the sake of your splendor; I cast you to the ground, I laid you before kings, That they might gaze at you. • Revelation 12:7-12 (NKJV) (Satan cast to the earth for a short time)

<sup>7</sup> And war broke out in heaven: Michael and his angels fought with the dragon; and the dragon and his angels fought,

- <sup>8</sup> but they did not prevail, nor was a place found for them in heaven any longer.
- <sup>9</sup> So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

 <sup>10</sup> Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, "Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down.

<sup>11</sup> And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

<sup>12</sup> Therefore rejoice, O heavens, and you who dwell in them! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and the sea! For the devil has come down to you, having great wrath, because he knows that he has a short time." • Revelation 20:1-3 (NKJV) (Satan bound)

<sup>1</sup> Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, having the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand.

<sup>2</sup> He laid hold of the dragon, that serpent of old, who is *the* Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years;

<sup>3</sup> and he cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal on him, so that he should deceive the nations no more till the thousand years were finished. But after these things he must be released for a little while.

#### Revelation 20:7-10 (NKJV) (Satan's End)

<sup>7</sup> Now when the thousand years have expired, Satan will be released from his prison

<sup>8</sup> and will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle, whose number *is* as the sand of the sea.

<sup>9</sup> They went up on the breadth of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city. And fire came down from God out of heaven and devoured them.

<sup>10</sup> The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet *are*. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

## Then all the earth shall know

• 1 Samuel 17:46-47 (NKJV)

<sup>46</sup> <u>that all the earth may know</u> that there is a God in Israel.

<sup>47</sup> Then all this assembly shall know that the LORD does not save with sword and spear; for the battle *is* the LORD'S,

• Ezekiel 39:28-29 (NKJV)

<sup>28</sup> <u>then they shall know that I *am* the LORD</u> their God,

• Ezekiel 48:35 (NKJV)

<sup>35</sup> All the way around *shall be* eighteen thousand cubits; and the name of the city from *that* day *shall be*: <u>THE LORD *IS* THERE</u>."
